## About Mawlyngbna

Mawlyngbna is a small village hidden in the beautiful state of Meghalaya. Located just 19 kilometers from Mawsynram. It is about 78 km from Shillong to the place. The scenic village of Mawlyngbna is located on a hilltop. This village offers a lot of adventure activities and it is also famous for its great folklore story (Ka Iew Luri Lura).

The village also has rich fossils of animals dating back to 200 million years. The forest on the outskirts of the village is famous for its predaceous pitcher plant. The dramatic sequence of the rolling khasi hills merging into the Bangladesh plains can be seen from the hilltop.

There are also a number of beautiful waterfalls among which the most notable ones are Um - Dikain and Ar - Phalat waterfalls. Mawlyngbna also offers many adventure activities like trekking, kayaking, boating, river rafting, river canyoning, cliff jumping and many more.

## Ka Iew Luri Lura (Market of Chaos)

The day begins with a short hike to “Ka Iew Luri Lura” (Market of Chaos). According to local folklore, Ka Iew Luri Lura was an animal market place thousands of years ago where animal could talk. The dents are considered as the footprints of these animals.

Mawlyngbna is also famous for its fossils, which are believed to be a millions of years old and are remnants of when the whole area was under the ocean.

## River Canyoning in Mawlyngbna

For anybody looking to discover adrenaline, River Canyoning in Mawlyngbna is the right place to be!. River canyoning involves trekking through the forest and follow the river downstream where one can swim, slide, and jump. ## Kayak at the beautiful Umkhakoi Lake

Apart from River Canyoning, guest can also indulge in flat water kayaking in the still waters of the picturesque Umkhakoi Lake where you can enjoy paddling the kayaks, using a double-bladed paddled to pull front and back and feel the thrill as you explore the serene lakes and its surrounding.

## Visit the Humungous Split Rock!

---

Split Rock is another wonders of Mawlyngbna and it's just 2.4 km from Umkhakoi Lake. The split rock is a unique huge rock which is split into two from top to bottom. The two rocks are high as a 3 or 4 storied building and the rocks sat parallel to each other. And according to the locals, the split was caused by a magnitude 8 Assam earthquake of 1897.

**Accommodation** - Guest house/Hotels/Homestays/Tents will be provided to the guest(s) at different locations according to the itinerary.


**Guides** - Guide charges are also included in the package
